Writer and psychiatrist, Patrick Autréaux has published poetry, short stories, and contemporary art criticism. His first auto-fictions deal with the experience of illness as an interior journey-- *Dans la vallée des larmes* (2009), *Soigner* (2010), and *Le Dedans des choses* (2012, prix Amic de la l'Académie française), all published by Gallimard, and concluding with *Se survivre* (2013) published by Verdier. *Les Irréguliers* (2015, Gallimard) is his first novel. One of his texts, “Le Grand Vivant,” with Thierry Thieû Niang, will be performed this spring.
